Education, Experience and Certifications:

Candidates must have at bachelor's degree at minimum, Master's Degree in an area of education preferred. Candidates must have a current Louisiana teaching certificate that includes the special education add-on certification. Experience in the classroom preferred but not required. Student teaching experience in special education classroom is required.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Complete specific trainings: child protection and first aid/CPR
- Familiarity of the formal evaluation process for students with special needs
- Ability to draft and implement a service plan
- Ability to maintain a positive learning environment including the implementation of individualized education plans
- Ability to maintain a clear, safe and orderly environment
- Ability to communicate appropriately to all stakeholders
- Knowledge of autism, specific learning disabilities, ADHD, and other health impairments
- Knowledge of the various baseline assessments and how to plot and track data over time
